This is further to our email of December 17, 2008 and has reference to your letter of September 30, 2007, seeking our comments on the acceptability of the subject product for use in food-contact applications. The subject product is intended to be used as a thermooxidative additive at a let down of 3 wt% in polyethylene laminate to be used in the manufacture of plastic pouches for the packaging of milk.

Based on the information submitted, we can advise that we see no reason to object to the use of the subject product as proposed, provided that it is technically suitable for its intended end-use.
